Watch carvers bring the ephemeral art of ice carving to life with chainsaws, chisels, grinders & knives, as well as hot irons and cold spray. Each carver starts with a single block of ice weighing 260 lbs. and dissects & reassembles it into wondrous creations.

**Morning Event: - 9:30am 'til Noon is the Team Competition where Two carvers have 2 ½ hrs, to make huge sculptures using 5 blocks of ice. At 12:30, carvers separate & carve a single block, they have 'til 3pm to create sculptures.**
